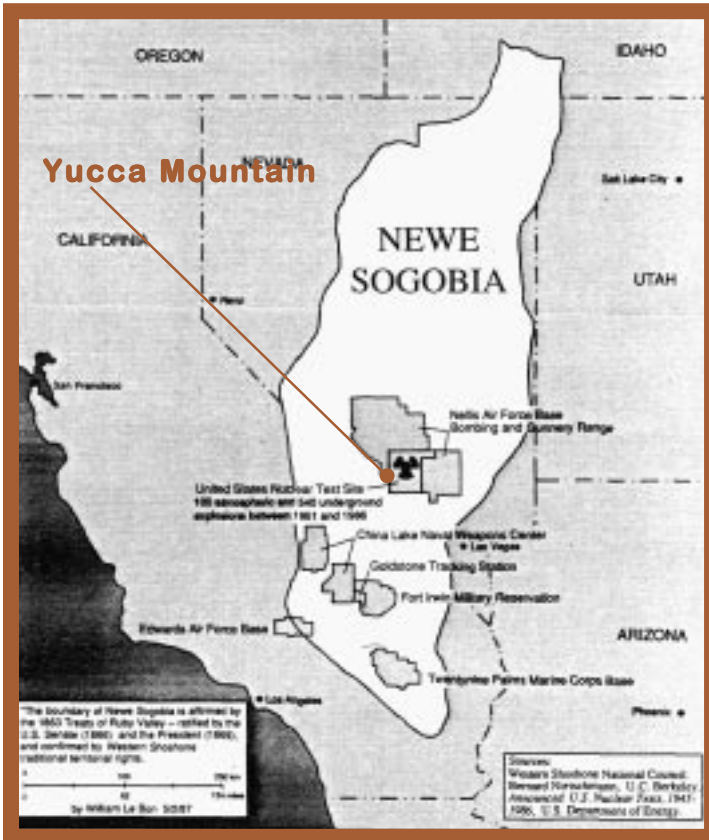


Yucca Mountain is in Newe Sogobia

Below is outlined land that was recognized by the U.S. government in 1863 in the Treaty of Ruby Valley as the aboriginal territory of the Western Shoshone people



The Treaty of Ruby Valley is still in force.

It is a treaty between nations.

According to international law the land inside the boundary is subject to Shoshone jurisdiction only.

It is the position of the Western Shoshone National Council that using Yucca Mountain as a nuclear waste dump violates this treaty.

From an international perspective a nuclear waste dump at Yucca Mountain is illegal.
